

## **AM**

### **LITERACY :**

1. The 'Which Word' worksheet is simply a draw a line from the picture to the correct word. The children then need to write the first letter which is common to the three words. They can colour the pictures if there is time. There are a number of similar worksheets in the pre-school section of Literacy.
2. The 'My First Sentence' worksheets is about introducing children to the sentence structure. Cut out the words on the first page and get the children to put them in the correct order. They can write the sentence on the second page. There are more similar sheets in the pre-school Literacy section of the site.
3. The reading activity has an instruction about how to colour the cat.

### **NUMERACY:**

1. There are five pages of activities for counting up to ten, including flash cards to cut out.
2. If you want to focus in on a specific number then the worksheets 'What is 5?' looks at the number five with the children colouring in five objects and partitioning five into the pairs that make five.

## **PM**

1. PSHE - You can either start or end the day with the PSHE story, allow about 20 minutes for the story and follow-up discussions. The story , 'Kicking Out' is about bullying on the playground.
2. There are two science sheets, one looking at the differences between birds and mammals and the other one looking at the characteristics of birds. They can colour the sheets when they are finished.
3. For Art they could make up their own colourful bird, making sure they have a beak, two legs and two wings !
