LITERACY :

1. The 'Which Word' worksheet is simply a draw a line from the picture to the correct word. The children then need to write the first letter which is common to the three words. They can colour the pictures if there is time. There are a number of similar worksheets in the pre-school section of Literacy.
2. The 'My First Sentence' worksheets is about introducing children to the sentence structure. Cut out the words on the first page and get the children to put them in the correct order. They can write the sentence on the second page. There are more similar sheets in the pre-school Literacy section of the site.
3. The reading activity has an instruction about how to colour the dog.

NUMERACY:

1. There are five pages of activities for counting from ten, including flash cards to cut out.
2. If you want to focus in on a specific number then the worksheets 'What is 6?' looks at the number six with the children colouring in six objects and partitioning six into the pairs that make six.

PM

1. PSHE - You can either start or end the day with the PSHE story, allow about 20 minutes for the story and follow-up discussions. The story , 'Losing a Friend' is about losing your best friend when they move away.
2. There are two science sheets, one looking at the differences between an animal and plants and the other one looking at the characteristics of farm animals. They can colour the sheets when they are finished.
3. For Art they could draw or paint animals on a farm. If you do an outline of a farm they could do little pictures of farm animals to go on it.
