### **LITERACY :**

1. The sentence builder activity uses 8 key words and there are a number of practice worksheets for the children to complete.
2. Phonics - children often confuse **ow** and **ou** and these worksheets look at where these letters occur. The first two have easy words and the next two are harder so you can give pages 3 and 4 to more able children.
3. The Let's Write worksheets give the less able a structure to their work. The more able can create their own sentences onto the second page without doing the first page. The theme is 'All About Me' ..... quite a nice one for a supply teacher if it is the first time you have worked with the class.

### **NUMERACY:**

1. The starter for numeracy is looking at an addition square. Children enjoy looking for patterns that they can colour in.
2. The add and subtract worksheets are developing quick recall of number bonds to 10.

## **PM**

PSHE - You can either start or end the day with the PSHE story, allow about 20 minutes for the story and follow-up discussions. The story, 'The New Shoes' is about peer group pressure to wear the same things and the financial consequences for parents.

You may only have time for one practical session in the afternoon, here are two ideas:

1. **SCIENCE** : The science activity is looking at what uses mains electricity. Stress the safety implications for electrical gadgets, especially those that produce heat and boiling water.
2. **ART** : If there is time for art they could draw items in their house that use electricity which you could stick onto a large outline of a house.
