LITERACY :

1. Phonics - children often confuse **ear** and **eer** and these worksheets look at where these letters occur. There are 8 pages , finishing with 10 key words from the KS1 list
2. The writing worksheets give the less able a structure to their work. The more able can create their own sentences about their favourite pet onto the second page without doing the first page.

NUMERACY:

1. The starter for numeracy is to look at odds and evens, there is a single page worksheet for the children to fill in after some board work.
2. The main activities look at numbers by using venn diagrams and linking up the odd/even theme with early tables.

PM

1. PSHE - You can either start or end the day with the PSHE story , 'George is Spoiling Our Game', allow about 20 minutes for the story and follow-up discussions.
2. SCIENCE : The science work looks at our senses , matching up parts of the body with the five senses and it finishes with the children being asked to write about how they would look after themselves.
3. ART : What would the world be like if we only had one colour?? Get them to paint a picture in only one colour. Talk about colour blindness and how some animals only see in black and white.
