LITERACY :

1. Phonics - children often confuse **oy** and **oi** and these worksheets look at where these letters occur. There are 8 pages , finishing with 10 key words from the KS1 list
2. The writing activity is about writing instructions, in this case, brushing their teeth. For less able children an adult could write the sentences and then cut them out for the children to put into the correct order. They can either stick them on a page or copy write into their book.

NUMERACY:

1. The starter for numeracy is looking at adding 3 numbers totalling up to 12. There is a simple worksheet for the children to fill in.
2. The main activities are looking at simple data handling and converting data into pictograms. There are 4 pages for the children to work on.

PM

1. PSHE - You can either start or end the day with the PSHE story , 'Getting Lost', allow about 20 minutes for the story and follow-up discussions. The story is about what to do when you get lost.
2. SCIENCE : The science work looks at the Oak tree, the parts of a tree and the creatures who depend on it for food.
3. ART : There is an art activity linked to the science in drawing trees. They may want to move on to painting a tree or using some other medium like oil pastels.
Or, if you draw a large tree the children can then draw and colour a range of creatures that either live on or eat the tree for you to stick on.
