LITERACY :

1. Start with the word level work looking at endings *-itch* and *-atch* .
2. The writing activity is about writing instructions, in this case for brushing teeth. This fits in nicely with the science activity about teeth.

NUMERACY:

1. The logic problem makes for a good starter, if any bright sparks get it quickly then they could design their own.
2. The counting and sequencing worksheets look at numbers up to 1000. There are 7 activity sheets so it should keep them busy till the end of the lesson. Able children who finish quickly could design their own questions similar to page 4 based on the hundred square. They would need squared paper for that work.

PM

1. **PSHE:** The story 'The Untidy Bedroom' is about the consequences of being untidy and disorganised.
2. **Science:** The worksheets on teeth look at the need to keep their teeth clean. There is a small picture for them to colour in as well as questions to answer.
3. **Art:** They might like to design their own posters about keeping their teeth clean.

Or, they might like to find and draw animals that have very specific types of teeth, for example grazing animals , herbivores, have large molars for grinding vegetation while carnivores have large canines for ripping up their prey.
