1. Start with the word level work looking at the beginning consonant blends of wh,th,sh and ch.

NUMERACY:

2. The Main maths activities are a series of 7 worksheets looking at adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers. The first two pages have a number line to help them but the more able may need to start on page 3.
