LITERACY :

1. The first activity in Literacy is phonics work looking at the letters j, g, ge, dge . They all make the same sound but have different letters making that sound.
2. For writing the children can write a report about their favourite soap on TV. The worksheet has a report about Coronation Street with comprehension questions.

NUMERACY:

1. The logic problem should take about 10 minutes as a maths starter. Brighter children may want to create their own problem.
2. The seven pages on time start by comparing analogue and digital clocks and then goes onto timetables and problem solving situations.

PM

1. PSHE : The story 'The Sweets' is about accepting what look like sweets but are in fact drugs.
2. SCIENCE: The science is about creating strong shapes with paper to support a heavy object. The worksheet suggests a brick but if you can't find a brick then any heavy object, like a 1KG weight, will do.
3. ART : Following the theme on shape from the science there are a number of examples of Picasso and his cubism style. This usually appeals to pupils and they can either copy an example or try their own.
