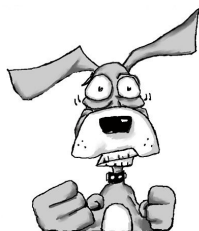
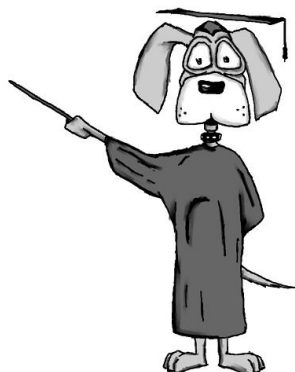


i before e ??????
